There they will find a determined group of individuals who will work with them to solve problems and get them back on a successful path.

When holidays like the Fourth of July come around when so many people are out having fun, it can be particularly hard on people who are struggling just to get by. Gateway Community Outreach can help many of these people - helping people reclaim their independence and financial freedom has been Gateway's mission for 18 years. Gateway Community Outreach has a 90 day treatment plan which focuses on stabilization to help the entire family. They also offer emergency assistance through their food and ancillary services.

"Our goal is to keep working with

them until they are stabilized. With our economic crisis, our numbers have increased. People who were not normally in the poverty level now don't have a job, and we are here to help them through this difficult time," said Carol Ray, Founder, President and CEO of Gateway Community Outreach.

Gateway makes a difference and has made a difference in the lives of over 180,000 families since its inception in 1995 and continues to provide services with compassion and care to their clients. Gateway provides a comprehensive crisis management program and has a dedicated staff and over 200 volunteers who continuously monitor all intake procedures, tracking performance and computer data input on a weekly basis.

Gateway collaborates with over 80 agencies throughout the county for emergency assistance concerns, as well as providing rent and mortgage assistance through FEMA's Emergency Food and Shelter Program (EFSP) funds. Through direct and personalized assistance, it is

often possible to work through a family's crisis and get people "back on their feet" before any significant damage is done.

"The need has increased. Right now, we service over 8,000 families. Our main focus is prevention. We try to keep people in their homes and just help them to get through a difficult time so they are still independent," said Ray. "The education component is so important. We offer free seminars and provide information needed to help people in our community." Carol Ray finds it rewarding to be able to keep families together.

"We have had many success stories of people coming back and saying that Gateway Community Outreach has helped them so much. It is satisfying to see this.
