

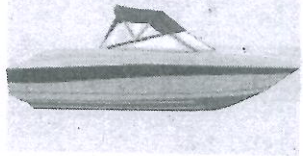

# Project 2<sup>nd</sup> Chance: LAST Opportunity to Register

The City of Deerfield Beach and District 2 Commissioner Ben Preston are excited to announce that the GED Completion Program, *Project 2<sup>nd</sup> Chance* has successfully launched.

This program was developed to give residents who have not completed their high school education a 2<sup>nd</sup> Chance.

Deerfield Beach has partnered with Broward County Schools and currently GED Completion classes are being

taught at the Central City Campus, 401 SW 4 St. As the summer approaches, city officials are hoping to keep the program in Deerfield Beach — but in order to do that, must meet an enrollment requirement set in place by the county.

In its efforts to prevent uprooting students currently enrolled in *Project 2<sup>nd</sup> Chance*, the city is opening up registration once more and offering residents one last opportunity to sign up for

classes.

Anyone interested in completing their GED **must sign up by April 28**.

Income-qualified individuals will pay \$3 for a session. Non qualifying individuals will pay standard fees.
